Types of Assessments

Outcome Assessments

- o Administered once per year or course
- Occurs after instruction
- Determines if we met outcomes
- o Measures students against standards or expectations
- Examples
 - EOG
 - EOC
 - CTE Post Assessments
 - ACT
 - ACT WorkKeys

Benchmark/Interim Assessments

- o Administered 3-4 times per year
- o Administered throughout the year after sections of instruction
- o Predict performance on outcome assessments
- Measure mastery of objectives
- Assess progress towards standards
- o Examples
 - NC CheckIns

Universal Screening Measures

- o Administered 2-3 times per year
- Standardized administration
- o Predictive of larger outcomes
- o Identifies students at-risk
- o Allows problem solving for: whole school, sub-groups, grade level skill gaps
- Examples
 - I-Ready ELA
 - I-Ready Math
