A. **Agenda Item**: Superintendent's Report

Presenter: Dr. Kimberly Elliott, Superintendent

Dr. Elliott reported on the following:

- 1. Dr. Elliott presented Ms. Angela Lunsford with the NCA CASI Certificate of Accreditation, the NC State Board of Education award for exceeding Academic Growth for 2017-2018.
- 2. Dr. Elliott stated that it has been an exciting and wonderful school year. JCPS students have excelled in many venues. The student achievement testing and accountability are in full swing and students are demonstrating success. Many awards programs have occurred in the past few days. JCPS athletes have been honored at many events.
- 3. Arts, Band and Performance Arts Programs are alive and thriving in JCPS. Blue Ridge and SMHS have concluded wonderful spring performances, and have won many competition awards this year.
- 4. The STEM, Robotics and Science Olympiad Teams have represented well and many teams have brought home multiple awards from regional, state and national competitions.
- 5. Several grants have been awarded to JCPS teachers and central staff, the partnerships with the Blue Ridge Education Foundation, WCU, SCC and Blue Ridge Health School Based Health Centers are stronger than ever.
- 6. JCPS has implemented efficiencies that have helped align the strategic plan and budget processes, have empowered principals to be excellent instructional leaders, and allowed JCPS to be excellent stewards of funding.
- 7. JCPS has maintained safety in our schools and have implemented capital improvements to take school safety to an even higher level. The Commissioners, Board of Education, Principals and Central Staff encourage a safe, caring, successful environment. Each student deserves the very best each and every day.
- 8. Dr. Elliott stated that she is extremely proud of the accomplishments this year. Principal of the Year, Brent Speckhardt has represented JCPS well, just as the previous Teacher of the Year Johnathan Parsons, and the current Teacher of the Year Dawn Gilchrist will continue to spotlight JCPS. Congratulations to the Retirees, Audrey Rice, District Support Employee of the Year (Blue Ridge), & District TOY for 19-20, Dawn Gilchrist (School of Alternatives). An Accolade of Appreciation goes to Cora Fields for excellent program planning and implementation of the Celebration Awards Event. Last evening was a wonderful time of comradery and celebration.
- 9. Board Members have much for which to be proud! Their leadership paves the road to success in Jackson County Public Schools.

Dr. Elliott introduced Ms. Pam Meister – Director, Mountain Heritage Center, WCU; Peter Koch – Education Associate, Mountain Heritage Center; and Tristan Reid – Student at WCU. Mr. Reid gave a presentation to honor and celebrate the Central Office building, a Rosenwald School, and all those who entered its doors to teach, learn, advocate, and educate our society as a whole.

B. **Agenda Item:** School Nutrition Community Eligibility Provision and Meal Prices Update **Presenter:** Laura Cabe, School Nutrition Director

Ms. Cabe presented information about the changes to the Community Eligibility Provision program. Three of the four schools that qualified for free and reduced lunch have fallen below the threshold of 40% and are no longer eligible for this program. Blue Ridge School, Blue Ridge Early

College, Smokey Mountain Elementary School, and School of Alternatives had previously qualified, with only the School of Alternatives remaining eligible for the program. The School Nutrition Program will be impacted with a \$130,000.00 financial loss and will require families to go through the application process to qualify for no-cost or low-cost meals. Lunch prices will not need to be increased due to the program having a positive balance in the school nutrition account as of Dec. 31, 2018.
