In February 2016, Jackson County Schools sponsored a “District Logo Contest” for students to develop a computer-generated logo to use for the entire school system. Student submissions came from Fairview School, Jackson County Early College, and Smoky Mountain High School. The goal was for JCPS to have a student-generated logo for publications, letters, etc. Having student involvement, creativity, and innovation in this process was very important as we showcase our student’s artistic and technological talent.
